Fit & comfort

Feeling comfortable, especially for a new rider, is one of the key factors when choosing a motorcycle. The Vulcan S was designed to be accommodating for a wide range of riders from short to tall.

Complementing the relaxed riding position, ERGO-FIT offers adjustable footpegs, easyreach handlebar and 2 different seat options allowing riders to custom-fit their bike to suit size and preference.
